

Symposium on Yolanda Recovery was held and letter of appreciation was given to IRIDeS from Eastern Visayas State University (2019/08/01-04)

Theme : Typhoon Haiyan, Coastal rebuilding
Place: Tacloban City, the Philippines

On August 1, 2019, IRIDeS held “Symposium on Yolanda Recovery: Reflections and Considerations on the Rebuilding Process”. IRIDeS has been working on the Leyte rebuilding since late 2013, immediately after Yolanda on November 8th, 2013. Initial field reconnaissance included assessments of damage, evacuation, public health, and community conditions. Members working on rebuilding continue working in Leyte up until now, to understand relocation, housing, infrastructure, and education issues.

This symposium shared the lessons learned from various activities developed in Yolanda-affected Leyte to rebuild better. While there is no single solution for better rebuilding, presenters shared different perspectives of complexities, challenges, and efforts observed in the rebuilding processes on the ground. Relocated communities also shared their experiences.

From IRIDeS, Associate Professor Kanako Iuchi (Human and Social Response Research Division) and Associate Professor Elizabeth Maly (Disaster Information Management and Public Collaboration Division) participated to present in the event. Following explains the presentation contents by the Japanese side.
