Theme: 2004 Indian Ocean Tsunami, 2011 Great East Japan Earthquake, General disaster prevention

IRIDeS, Tohoku University and Graduate School of Mathematical Sciences, Syiah Kuala University renewed their Inter-Academic Exchange Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding on November 7, 2019.
