Place : South West England (Plymouth, Bath and Bristol)


Assoc. Prof. Anawat Suppasri (Tsunami Engineering Lab) is visiting University College London (UCL) from April 2023. From 12<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> June, he visited few tsunami experts in South West England.

During 13<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup> June, he visited coastal areas of Plymouth including the affected area of the storm surge in 2014, discussed further collaboration on coastal engineering, comparative study on tsunami reconstruction, exchange of young researcher with Prof. Alison Raby and delivered an invited talk to faculty members and students in Faculty of Engineering and Faculty of Science at the University of Plymouth. On the 15<sup>th</sup> June, he had a meeting with Dr. Mohammad Heidarzadeh at University of Bath regarding tsunami generation mechanism and damage assessment. On the 16<sup>th</sup> June, he delivered an invited talk to faculty members and students in Faculty of Engineering and Faculty of Science at the University of Bristol and discussed further collaboration with Dr. Raffaele De Risi on tsunami risk assessment.

This visit initiated another step forward for strengthening collaboration between IRIDeS and universities in the UK through tsunami engineering related research topics.
